# PRESENTATION OF THE 25 GOVERNOR'S AWARDS OF EXCELLENCE

**The Artist:** Adam Brouillette was born in the mid-west in 1980. He grew up in the suburbs, spending most of his time making forts, playing legos, watching cartoons, and drawing. He attended Columbus College of Art and Design with the hopes of becoming a comic book illustrator, but ended up falling in love with printmaking and the process-oriented manner in which it operates. Since graduating from Columbus College of Art and Design in 2002, his work has been exhibited in several galleries and institutions in Ohio and outside the state.

Adam is involved in several organizations related the arts. He serves as President of the Couchfire Collective <<http://www.thecouchfire.org/>>, Secretary of the Ohio Art League <<http://www.oal.org/>>, manager of Junctionview Studios <<http://www.junctionviewstudios.com/>>, Founder of Wonderland, owner of littleINDUSTRIES, and has founded and run such events as Agora and Independents' Day Festival. His efforts are result of continued hard work and effort toward the goal of making Columbus and its arts culture the best it can possibly be.

Adam also spent nine years as an educator mentoring Columbus area high school students, helping them design portfolios and produce applications for college. He has three years of education in adolescent psychology, early childhood development, and pedagogy. He also frequently works with area colleges as a consultant to their fine arts and entrepreneurship programs.



**The Award:** These awards were designed in the spirit of the students Adam has taught. Unlike trophies and ribbons for awards that are often placed on a shelf, he wanted to create a piece of fun, irreverent artwork that students receiving the award would carry with them and display. The character depicted is familiar to his style, a modified stick figure with very human attributes. The expression of elation on the character is an intentional suggestion to the students that they too should be excited about their awards. The works were made through a serigraphic process coupled with hand painting. Each painting is similar, yet unique as part of the edition.

## THE OHIO GOVERNOR’S YOUTH ART EXHIBITION

The Ohio Governor’s Youth Art Exhibition, now in its fortieth year, is dedicated to the educational and artistic advancement of our talented young people in the state of Ohio. The Exhibition is open to all of Ohio’s 1,052 high schools, both public and private, chartered by the State of Ohio Department of Education. Our purpose is to provide all budding young artists of the state with opportunities to advance their talent, whether that be through scholarships or simply experiencing the process of entering their work in a competition. The Exhibition is a valuable incentive for our young people; it encourages an appreciation for the arts throughout Ohio and reflects the fine quality of art instruction and talent that exist in our state.

The process of selecting art works for the State Exhibition begins on a regional level. The state is divided into 15 regional locations, with high school students in each region invited to enter work in that regional judging. Each region has a designated Regional Director, who is responsible for choosing the judges for his or her region and arranging specifics of the event.

This state judging takes place in Columbus; however, the judges for this level of competition are chosen from all over the country and are generally professional artists themselves, college level instructors, or both.

From the 12,500 regional entries from the 15 regions, approximately 3,000 are selected to enter the state judging. State jurors then select 300 for the actual Exhibition, with 25 of the 300 chosen to receive the Governor’s Award of Excellence. Scholarships are offered to seniors by more than 30 universities and colleges of art. The selection of students to be offered scholarships is left strictly up to those institutions who offer them. The Governor’s Exhibition is merely a vehicle through which schools and students are brought together.

The Exhibition opens at the James A. Rhodes State Office Tower, across from the state capitol, in April and closes near the end of May. An awards ceremony is held at the Riffe Center Capitol Theatre in the students’ honor prior to the opening. The attendance at the awards ceremony is over 700 and the Exhibition attendance is at least 1,200. At the Exhibition awards ceremony, students receive Awards of Excellence and scholarship awards.
