## 2019 SCHOLARSHIPS

Presentation by the Sponsors:

### Art Academy of Cincinnati

- scholarships of \$10,000 are available, and are in addition to entrance scholarship upon acceptance.

- scholarships ranging from \$16,000 to \$24,000 are available and renewable

- scholarships ranging from \$10,000 to \$25,000 are available

### Marietta College, Art Department

- scholarships ranging from \$500 to \$3,500 are available based on portfolio review

### Maryland Institute, College of Art

- one to ten scholarships of \$8,000 and \$12,000 over four years are available to state exhibitors, and additional scholarships are available on a competitive basis

### Milwaukee Institute of Art & Design

- scholarships in the amount of \$16,000 per year are available contingent on successful application and GPA requirement

### The Modern College of Art & Design

- up to five scholarships in the amount of \$5,000 (renewable for \$10,000 value) are available to state exhibitors in the top 300

### Montserrat College of Art

- two scholarships at \$5,000 are reserved for state exhibitors

### Mount St. Joseph University

- academic scholarships ranging from \$9,000 to \$21,000 are available

### Myers School of Art, University of Akron

- one scholarship of \$800 is available for a student enrolled with a major in Art.

### Ohio Art Education Association and Ohio Art Education Foundation

- one scholarship of \$700 to a Top 300 exhibitor and one \$300 Educator's Grant to that student's teacher, provided they are an OAEA member

- scholarships of up to \$4,000 are available for art majors, based on portfolio review

- free entry of up to ten artworks for all Top 25 students, entry deadline is June 20, 2019

- two scholarships of \$500 are available to state exhibitors majoring in Studio Art

### Ohio University, School of Art + Design

- scholarships ranging from \$10,000 to \$20,000 over four years are available to state exhibitors

### Otterbein University, Department of Art

- one scholarship of \$2,000 is available to high school juniors selected by Otterbein Art Dept Faculty

### Savannah College of Art and Design

- scholarships of at least \$3,000 are available to all state exhibitors in the top 300, and scholarships of at least \$500 are available for the SCAD pre-college summer program for students among the top 300 in the state exhibition

### School of the Art Institute of Chicago

- scholarships of \$2,000 are available to state exhibitors, as well as merit scholarships to those admitted

### School of Visual Arts, New York

- one \$20,000 per year scholarship is available to an exhibitor admitted to SVA

## PRESENTATION OF THE 25 GOVERNOR'S AWARDS OF EXCELLENCE

**THE ARTIST:** Kate Morgan holds a BFA in Photography from the Columbus College of Art & Design. Frustrated by the digital world for not being tactile enough, she turned to mixed media. Morgan is inspired by folklore, mythology & the human form. Layers of collage are mixed with her ink washed drawings to address symbolic, cultural, historical & spiritual themes with purposeful vagueness, allowing them to be familiar to a variety of audiences. "I want my work to be the beginning of a dialogue, not a confrontation."

**THE AWARDS:** Morgan created something that is a reminder for all of us. Each piece is made with a print of an original drawing as the main subject. The background & gold leaf moon, however, are different for each piece. We are all alike in many ways but we come from different places with different experiences, and because of that, the light that guides each of us is different. It comes in many shapes & sizes. This piece is meant to serve as a reminder that YOUR light is your own. Be true to it & it will be true to you.

## THE OHIO GOVERNOR’S YOUTH ART EXHIBITION

The Ohio Governor’s Youth Art Exhibition, now in its forty-ninth year, is dedicated to the educational and artistic advancement of our talented young people in the state of Ohio. The Exhibition is open to all of Ohio’s 1,052 high schools, both public and private, chartered by the State of Ohio Department of Education. Our purpose is to provide all budding young artists of the state with opportunities to advance their talent, whether that be through scholarships or simply experiencing the process of entering their work in a competition. The Exhibition is a valuable incentive for our young people; it encourages an appreciation for the arts throughout Ohio and reflects the fine quality of art instruction and talent that exist in our state.

The process of selecting art works for the State Exhibition begins on a regional level. The state is divided into 14 regional locations, with high school students in each region invited to enter work in that regional judging. Each region has a designated Regional Director, who is responsible for choosing the judges for his or her region and arranging specifics of the event.

This state judging takes place in Columbus; however, the judges for this level of competition are chosen from all over the country and are generally professional artists themselves, college level instructors, or both.

From the more than 10,500 regional entries from the 14 regions, approximately 2,500 are selected to enter the state judging. State jurors then select 300 for the actual Exhibition, with 25 of the 300 chosen to receive the Governor’s Award of Excellence. Scholarships are offered to seniors by more than 30 universities and colleges of art. The selection of students to be offered scholarships is left strictly up to those institutions who offer them. The Governor’s Exhibition is merely a vehicle through which schools and students are brought together.

The Exhibition opens at the James A. Rhodes State Office Tower, across from the state capitol, in April and closes near the end of May. An awards ceremony is held at the Riffe Capitol Theatre in the students’ honor. The attendance at the awards ceremony is over 700 and the Exhibition attendance is at least 1,200. At the Exhibition awards ceremony, students receive Awards of Excellence and scholarship awards.

Under her direction, the state developed its first set of arts standards and companion curriculum materials; implemented a regional professional development program for arts educators; and forged new, expanded relationships between the ODE, arts organizations and educational service centers. Currently, Nancy is a practicing artist focused on painting and mixed media arts. During her time at ODE, Nancy also served as a member of the Ohio Governor's Youth Art Exhibition's Advisory Board, where she was greatly valued as a leading voice for innovation and change.
